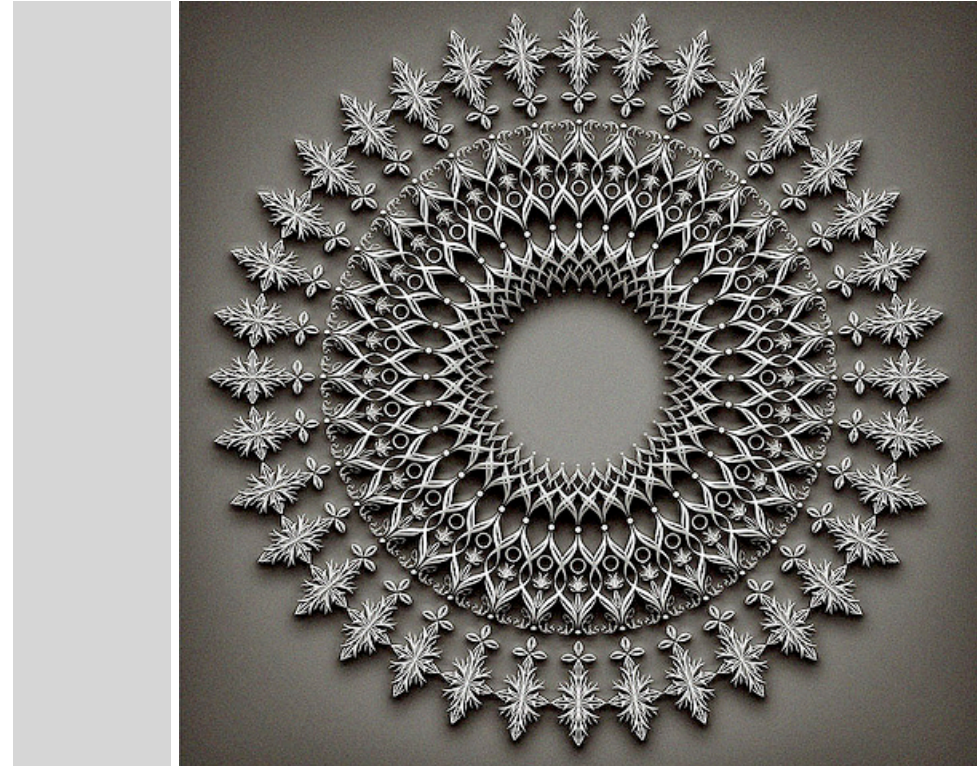

Aura Color Meanings

Red

[+] Love issues. Success. Passion for life. Vitality. Well-grounded.
[-] Anger. Over- or under-expressed sexuality. Too much energy.
Resentment. Challenges with male energies.

Pink

[+] Higher Self. Unconditional love. Female energies. Intuition.
Creativity.
[-] Need for (self) love. Lack of hope. Smothering love. Childhood
issues. Challenges with female energies.

Peach

[+] Pleasant situation. Happiness or contentment in personal
relationships. Wisdom of love.
[-] Unrequited or unreciprocated love — love given but not
returned. Broken promises. Distrust. Lack of joy.

Orange

[+] Creativity. Good friendships. Sociable. Financial control.
[-] Trauma. Physical shock (after accidents, surgery, illness, etc).
Need to heal from the past. Financial concerns.

Gold

[+] Artistic. Performer. Deep insight. Extreme happiness.
Enlightenment. Personal riches.
[-] Need for wisdom. Deep anxiety and frustration. Deep fear.

Yellow

[+] Mental activity. Joy. Acquired knowledge. Intellectual agility.
Curiosity. Enthusiasm.
[-] Scattered energies. Anxiety and fear. Mental confusion.
Indecision. Lack of understanding. Anticipation. Worry.

Olive

[+] Understanding. Practical optimism. Balanced intellect and
emotions. Lives simply.
[-] Difficulty integrating emotions. Fearful. Lives in denial. Envious.
Bitter.

Green

[+] Abundance. Self-healing. Regeneration. Balance. Love of
nature. Emotional clarity.
[-] Envy. Emotionally challenged. Desire to be in someone else's
space. Jealousy.

Turquoise

[+] Healing others. Giving. Altruistic. Teaching. Philanthropy. Self
responsibility. Philosophical.
[-] Blames others. Self-imposed isolation. Difficulty expressing
feelings.

Aura Color Meanings continued

Blue

- [+] Good communicator. Sense of inner peace and calm. Expressive. Nurturing.
- [-] Lack of peace. Difficulties communicating. Lack of will power. Depression.

Indigo

- [+] Third eye is open. Positive detachment. Idealistic. Psychic. Deeply spiritual.
- [-] Lack of clarity. Sense of isolation and futility. Difficulties or unresolved issues with father.

Violet or Purple

- [+] Selfless service. Spiritual calling. Alignment with spiritual path. Lightworker. Highly intuitive. Spiritual completion. Transformation. Spiritually protected.
- [-] Aloof. Arrogant. Overly responsible. Unwilling to help.

Magenta

- [+] Humanitarian. Loving service on a global scale. Sacrifice for the highest good of others. Finds joy in the little things. Optimistic.
- [-] Extreme need for unconditional love. Feels unworthy. Difficulties or unresolved issues with mother. Pessimistic.

White

- [+] Ideas. Decisions. Purity. Clarity. Release. A challenge transcended or transformed into something positive. Strength of will. Illumination. Impenetrable protection.
- [-] Excess. Impure intentions. Lack of clarity. Suffering. Lack of focus. Indecisiveness.

Black

- [+] Protective cloak shielding from external energies. Great focus and power.
- [-] A void. Repression. Lack of physical energy. Health issues.

The Chakras

7 – Seventh – The Crown Chakra

Relative location – the top of the head; the fontanel

Color association – white

Connection to Spirit/Source; the Higher Self; Divinity; Imagination; Cosmic Consciousness; Universal Collective Intelligence

Crown chakra lessons are about living in the present; faith in a Higher Power; spiritual guidance; inner wisdom; devotion and prayer.

Crown chakra challenges often show up as a need to understand or to know why things happen the way that they do, which often ultimately results in being stuck in the past.

6 – Sixth – Third Eye Chakra

Relative location – the center of the forehead; between the eyebrows

Color association – light purple, lavender, lilac

Intuition; the Truth; Wisdom

Third eye chakra lessons are about seeking the truth; intellectual processes; insight; inspiration; clairvoyance; wisdom from external life experiences; memory; dreams.

Third eye challenges often show up as self-delusion or defining the “truth” in ways that are self-serving.

5 – Fifth – Throat Chakra

Relative location – the throat; the vocal cords

Color association – blue

Self-expression; Communication; Speaking and Listening; Choice

Throat chakra lessons are about faith; self-knowledge; personal authority; authenticity; speaking your truth; personal will.

Throat chakra challenges often show up as a need to control or manipulate other people and or micromanage events. Obsession. Projection.

4 – Fourth – Heart Chakra

Relative location – the heart; the chest; the sternum or breastbone

Color association – green

Love and Compassion; Healing; Self-love, Self-care, Self-acceptance, Self-worth.

Heart chakra lessons are about forgiveness; dedication; inspiring others; hope; trust; the ability to heal or capacity to receive healing.

Heart chakra challenges often show up in the form of jealousy, anger, resentment, the ability to forgive; carrying around residual toxic emotions.

The Chakras continued

3 – Third – Solar Plexus Chakra

Relative location – just above the navel; the belly; the gut

Color association – yellow

Self-respect; Personal Honor; Personal power; Constructive action; Self-control

Solar plexus chakra lessons are about self-esteem; discipline; ambition; courage; generosity or protecting others; ethics; animal instincts.

Solar plexus chakra challenges often show up as giving away your power of choice or denying healthy boundaries; a need for someone else's approval; narcissism; "navel gazing" self-obsession or self-centered behavior.

2 – Second – Sacral Chakra

Relative location – just below the navel; just above the genitals

Color association – orange

Creativity; Sexuality; Vitality; Life Force

Sacral chakra lessons are about honoring one another; an ability to instigate, to initiate, to create; survival instincts (primal "flight or fight" responses); risk-taking; resilience and perseverance; sexuality; financial power.

Sacral chakra challenges often show up as disempowering, using, or taking advantage of other people for your own advantage.

1 – First – Root Chakra

Relative location – the perineum; the tailbone; the buttocks

Color association – red

Grounded-ness; Connection to Reality; Safety; Survival; All is One

Root chakra lessons are about safety and a sense of home; tribal identity and family; social bonds; shared, communal material resources; loyalty; a sense that we are all connected, as One.

Root chakra challenges often show up as illusions of superiority; group and identity politics; mob-mentality; exclusion of others; prejudice; irrational, unfounded defensiveness; paranoia; fear as a source of power.

The Houses

1 First House – Identity – Ego – Personality

Establishing a sense of physical self, individualized separate personality, early childhood, birth/re-birth of the self, self-sufficiency, strength to proceed without requiring permission, taking charge of who you are at your core and who/what you came here to become.

(First and Third Chakras)

Sign: Aries

Element: Fire

2 Second House – Self-worth – Life Values

Possessions, earning potential, self-esteem, your relationship to the physical, material world, what you value the most, what you associate with earthly, material, or physical power – such as money, financial power, social status, political influence, how you feel about your ability to control or coerce others. But also the physical, tactile, the sensual/sensory world, art, beauty, your surroundings, nature, the attachment to physical form.

(Second Chakra)

Sign: Taurus

Element: Earth

3 Third House – Knowledge – Self-expression – Siblings

Communication, how you express yourself to the world in a unique and creative way. The reason your sisters and brothers are represented here is because it's your first opportunity to establish yourself within the context of community – Where do you fit into the group? What do you have to contribute that makes you special? Also, how you learn to exercise your power in the world and the effect your choices, actions, and words have on other people. Becoming conscious of your sense of responsibility and the consequences of how you express yourself.

(Third and Fifth Chakras)

Sign: Gemini

Element: Air

4 Fourth House – Home – Family

Foundation of the emotional self, your self-expression is grounded in both the home you came from and your present home. Connections to your biological family and the extended family you invent through friendships. This house can manifest as toxic, residual memories and unhealed emotions. Resolving the issues of childhood and establishing a healthy home as an adult.

(First and Fourth Chakras)

Sign: Cancer

Element: Water

The Houses continued

5 Fifth House – Creativity – Fortune/Luck – Children

Creative ability, capacity for joy, spontaneity, ability to laugh/have fun, charisma, romance, sexuality, risk-taking, courage, children. The strengths you should most rely on when Making Things Happen, your free will, taking action, manifesting. Intelligence and imagination. Regulating your sexual and creative power so that you are not using personal power for seduction, manipulation, or selfish ends.

(Sixth Chakra)

Sign: Leo

Element: Fire

6 Sixth House – Work – Service – Health

Occupation, responsibilities, health, desires, your style of serving other people. Grounding your energy as an individual to your life's work, a survival-oriented focus on occupation and how you seek out paths to security. Your Sixth House archetype will come into play in how you interpret business-related opportunities and transactions. Balancing work and health. Negotiating morals and ethics in conjunction with job security. Closely corresponds to the money and values of the Second House.

(Second Chakra)

Sign: Virgo

Element: Earth

7 Seventh House – Relationships – Marriage – Partnerships

Primary relationships, marriage or romantic partnerships, business partnerships and professional relationships, close friendships. Libra governs intimate communication between individuals (unlike Gemini, which rules general communication style). Can also relate to betrayal and the shadow forces at work within partnerships.

(Second and Fourth Chakras)

Sign: Libra

Element: Air

8 Eight House – Joint Resources – Sexuality – Transformation

Other people's resources you may leverage, inheritance, or shared resources, sexuality, secrets, transformation, death/rebirth. Closely guarded emotional nature, secrets, as well as passions in an erotic context. (The most closely guarded secrets are about Sex, Money, or both.) Money in a public environment, legal concerns, family DNA, ancestors, biological or cellular memory. The pathway between personal, internal power, and external or public or social power.

(Second and Sixth Chakras)

Sign: Scorpio

Element: Water

The Houses continued

9 Ninth House – Beliefs – Spirituality

Ideas about the world, education, philosophy, religion, travel, and wisdom. Independence and personal quests. Devotion and passion that fuel your personal relationship with the Divine. Transcendence of the Spirit, enlightenment, ascension, and the spiritual ego (martyrdom and “the dark night of the soul”). Together with the Tenth House, the guiding principle that life is a spiritual journey. Monastic or personal spiritual quests for enlightenment in our interior lives, as opposed to social religious life. Retreating into your “Tower” to go deep within can often result in a kind of madness.

(Seventh Chakra)
Sign: Sagittarius
Element: Fire

10 Tenth House – Ethics – Career – Purpose

Reputation, career, social responsibility, highest potential, sense of purpose. The drive to become all that you can as a physical and spiritual being. Compassion and generosity. The highest use of your God-given talent. Spiritual destiny. Processing your potential options and what motivates your decisions. The Tenth House is the home of self-sabotaging behavior, doubt, lack of faith, fear of failure and fear of success.

(Fifth and Seventh Chakras)
Sign: Capricorn
Element: Earth

11 Eleventh House – Community – Society

Aspirations, social life, relationship to the world, place in a greater global community, your place in the cosmic tribe. Callings toward paths of service, such as philanthropy, environmentalism, or international peace keeping, that have a global impact. Optimism and pessimism about the potential Ascension and the evolving consciousness of humanity. Larger-than-life personae and the belief that anything under the sun is possible.

(Fourth and Sixth Chakras)
Sign: Aquarius
Element: Air

12 Twelfth House – Spirituality – Higher Self – The Collective

Subconscious mind, collective unconscious, privacy, interior, intuition, instinct, the soul, karmic lessons, mystery, esoteric and arcane knowledge. The unconscious mind, including our innermost, most deep-seated fears, surface through dreams, signs, and synchronicities. Intuitive abilities, circling back into the other houses and forming a sense of completion, the connection or relationship between primal gut-instinct and higher spiritual intuition.

(Sixth and Seventh Chakras)
Sign: Pisces
Element: Water
